The European Movement International offers an ongoing traineeship programme for a duration of 3-6 months, aimed at students wanting to gain experience in the Brussels office of a network pro-European organisations. **The next possible opportunity to start is February 2023 for a duration of 3 months.**

As EU Affairs Trainee, you will have the opportunity to support different areas of our work, by contributing to our **policy and advocacy** work, drafting and editing content for our **communication** channels and assisting with the organisation of **events**.

Overview of main tasks

- Monitoring of developments in the policy areas covered by the European Movement
- Preparation of EU news updates and a weekly institutional agenda
- Research-related tasks and working on new policy positions and policy-focused newsletters
- Editing and drafting content for the European Movement website
- Drafting content for social media (Twitter, Facebook, Instagram and LinkedIn)
- Logistical and organisational support ahead of events

The traineeship can be adapted to your interests and your university's requirements.

Requirements

- Student status
- An interest in EU Affairs
- Strong analytical and writing skills in English (additional languages are an asset)
- Good organisational skills and an ability to cope with fast-changing environments
- Eligibility to live and work in Belgium

Remuneration

Please note that there is no budget foreseen for this position. Candidates are required to be in full-time education at the time of their application, and fulfilling a work placement requirement at university, with funding such as an Erasmus+ (etc.) available to cover their traineeship. Monthly public transport travel costs in Brussels and insurance are covered by the European Movement International.
